SOWING SUCCESS: TARDA'S BOLD EXPANSION IN SORGHUM PRODUCTION FOR NATIONAL FOOD SECURITY





Threshing and winnowing took place on the week of 12th- 16th August 2024 at TARDA's demonstration farms in Masinga and Kiambere, where recently harvested sorghum across 75 and 82 acres, respectively. With impressive yields of 700 to 900 kg per acre, the threshing process highlights the productivity and potential of these farms.

We're committed to expanding both farms to 200 acres each, a move that will significantly enhance our capacity to contribute to Kenya's food security. By increasing sorghum production, we're not only supporting local farmers and communities but also making a substantial impact on the national food supply chain.

This initiative is part of TARDA's broader strategy to promote sustainable agricultural practices, improve land productivity, and drive economic growth in the region. Our efforts are aligned with national goals to boost food production and ensure that every Kenyan has access to nutritious and affordable food.

UNLOCKING THE FUTURE: ADVANCED GIS & AI FOR REGIONAL GROWTH





A team from TARDA recently completed a transformative training at the Regional Centre for Mapping of Resources for Development (RCMRD) focused on **#SpatialDataScience** and **#AI** for Advanced **#GIS**. The training covered advanced GIS, web GIS applications, remote sensing using Google Earth Engine and essential **#Python** programming for spatial data handling and **#visualization**. By integrating these skills with statistical analysis and machine learning concepts, our team is now well-prepared to implement spatial prediction models, classification and deep learning techniques for satellite image analysis.

These new capabilities will be vital as TARDA continues to play a key role in regional planning, environmental conservation and sustainable development initiatives. By leveraging AI and GIS, we can optimize resource allocation, improve project efficiency, and make data-driven decisions that will accelerate growth across our regions. From enhancing irrigation projects to promoting food security and managing natural resources, TARDA is committed to utilizing these advanced technologies to bring transformative change to communities.
